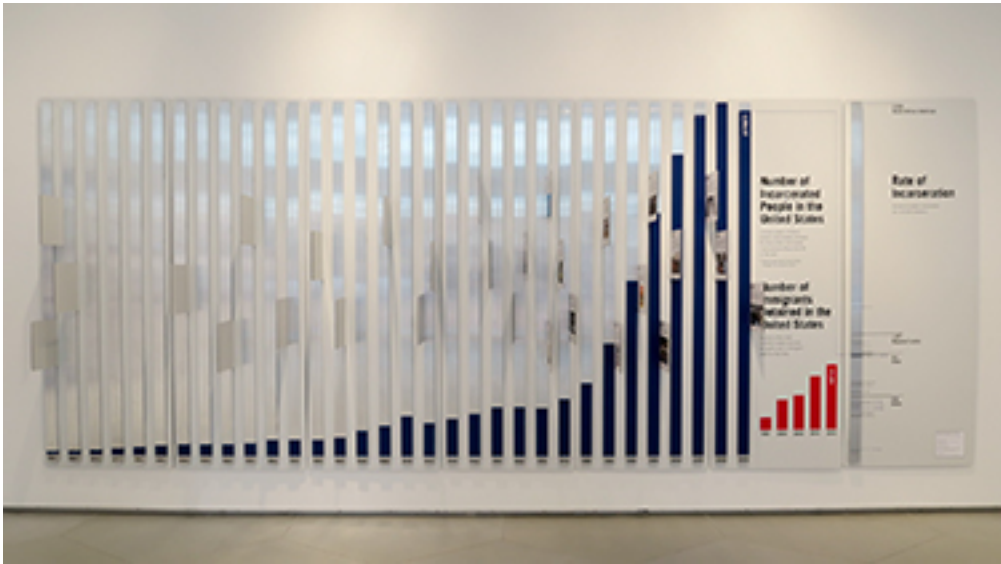

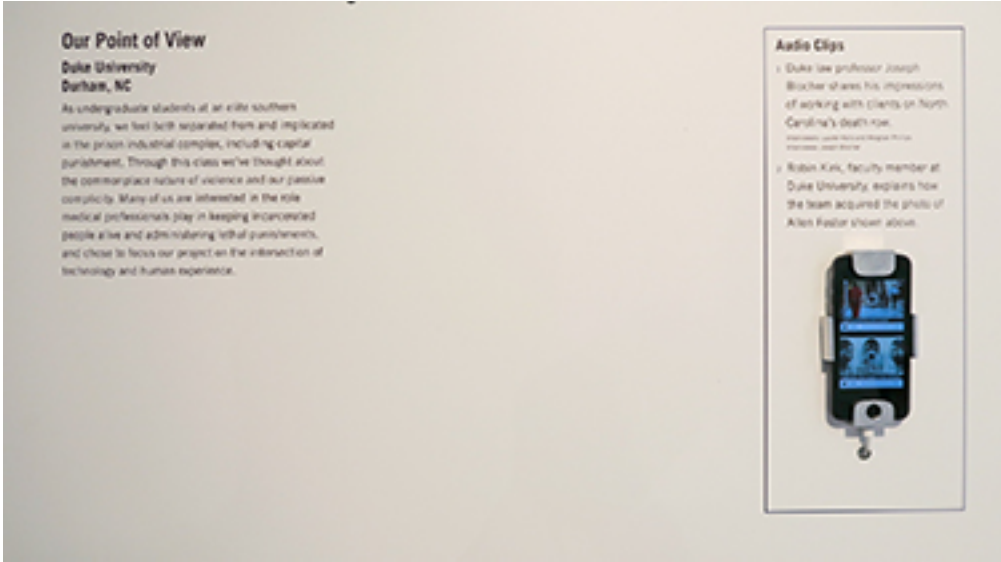

**Top Left:** Goddard Farm, c. 1900. Goddard began shipping produce regularly to Princeton and New York around 1900. Goddard Farm grows vegetables raised at outdoor stations, often overnight, to pack ships. (from *Common Seed Stories*)

**Top Right:** After 1933, Goddard Farm became famous for fast-freezing vegetables that had been sown in the ground in New York earlier. Here workers remove damaged and misshapen (big beans and corn). (from *U.S. 10*)
